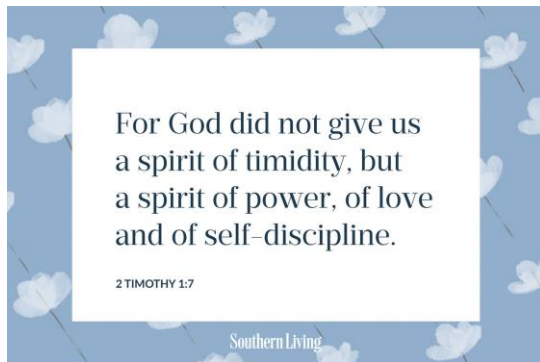

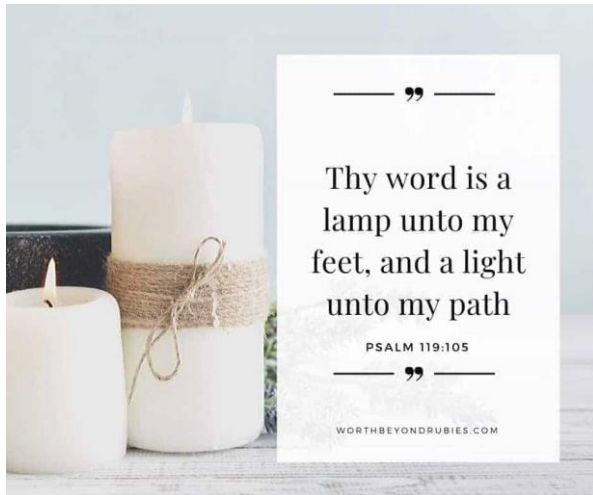
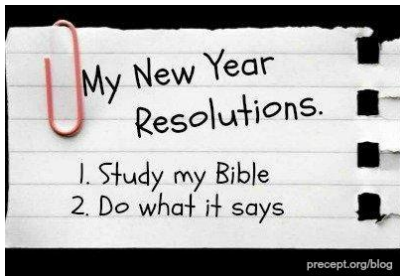
Happy New Year Mitchell Family!
